

The Sunday Show & Swap Meet:

- Parking for attendees is the **Yellow Lot** (see map below). The gate is located on the north side of the fairgrounds on Silverton Road.
- \$5 parking fee is collected by fairgrounds at the parking entrance.
- \$5 OVM show fee is also collected at the gate by the OVM volunteers.
- Attendees showing a motorcycle get an **entry pass** provided by OVM. Please contact the OVM (info@oregonvintage.org or Sam Justice & Jim Harrison) so we can prepare the pass ahead of time. Tell us what bike you will be showing make, model & year. We expect to have extra passes at the gate.
- Membership signup/renewal happens in the 4-H building at the OVM table. Only \$5 is collected by OVM at the gate and then the membership is \$15.

Vendor info:

- Vendors enter through the **Vendor Gate located on the north side of the fairgrounds on Silverton Road**. The Vendor Gate is about 150 feet east of the Yellow gate.
- Vendors plan to start setting up around 730AM. Once set up, a representative from the OVM will collect fees.
- Vendor tables are expected to be positioned inside the 4-H building, around the outer edge (or against the "walls") and facing inwards. In case of rain the bike show will take the center of the building.
- Vendor parking is on the outside of the Gate. Vendors can unload in the building and then pull out to make room for other Vendors based on space.
- Vendors who sign up for an OVM membership cover the vendors' fee.

- Registration procedure.

Members displaying a motorcycle contact the OVM by May 12th (info@oregonvintage.org or Sam Justice & Jim Harrison) so we can prepare a list of passes. Send us your name, contact information, make, model and year of the motorcycle(s).

- Event Logistics

In case of rain, Vendors around outer edge in 4-H building and bikes in middle

Clear skies, Bikes in center of grassy field, vendors in 4-H building.

Camping will be around the edge of field, so bikes can be displayed in center of field.

Displaying bikes, Bring oil pans, pig mats or cardboard in case of accidents.

Tables for OVM (renewals, T-Shirts, awards etc.) supplied by fairgrounds (5-6 tables 4-6 chairs ea. table)

Camping:

- Cost per night: Tent \$20, Electric \$25, full \$35 (all sites no fires)
- Location: Entry is the Walk-In gate (see below) on Silverton Road (We oversee security)
- How to reserve.
